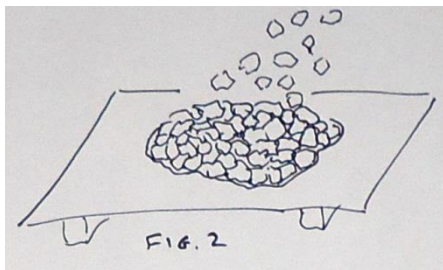
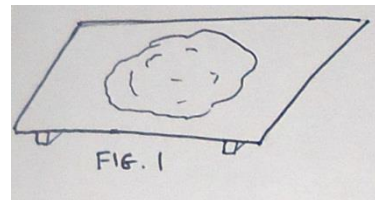


INSTRUCTIONS FOR BUFFALO CHIP FIRESTARTER MOLD

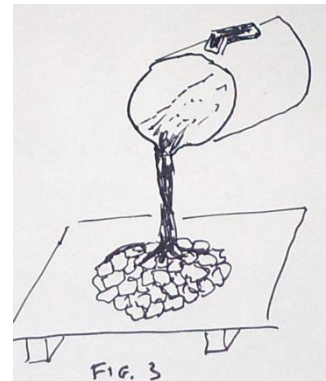
THESE INSTRUCTIONS EXPLAIN HOW TO CREATE BUFFALO CHIP FIRESTARTERS. THESE ARE NOT CANDLES AND SHOULD NEVER BE USED AS SUCH!

1. Your buffalo chip mold is a one piece plastic craft mold. It has one formed buffalo chip well and a built in "stand." Set up mold so the well is open to the top and it is standing on its "stand." (FIGURE 1)



2. Fill the well with wood chip. Pack the wood chips down by hand so they fill the well, but do not overflow. When you are done, the chips should completely fill the well and be relatively level across the open top of the well. (FIGURE 2)

3. Once the well is filled, pour hot wax over the wood chips. The wood chips will absorb the wax and, as time passes and the wax settles, you may need to refill the mold. Once refills (if needed) have been completed, allow the mold adequate time to set. (FIGURE 3)



4. After the piece sets, drop out of the casting. You can now use your firestarter!

5. To use your firestarter, place into fireplace or other fire safe container. Use a lighter to light the exposed wood chips that protrude from the wax. Once they get burning, the firestarter will slowly grow into a fairly large – but controlled – flame that will last for 15 minutes or more. Plenty long to get your fire going!
